He is the former Minister of State for External Affairs of the U.S. Virgin Islands Government, He has served as governance advisor to the Governments of Anguilla, Bermuda, Curacao, Sint Eustatius, and French Polynesia; United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and Independent Expert to United Nations (U.N.) special missions to Bermuda and the Turks & Caicos Islands, respectively. He has served as a visiting lecturer in Global Affairs in the University of the Virgin Islands Institute for Future Global Leaders, and visiting lecturer at the University of Guam where he introduced the Dependency Governance academic curriculum. He lectures globally on dependency governance studies.
